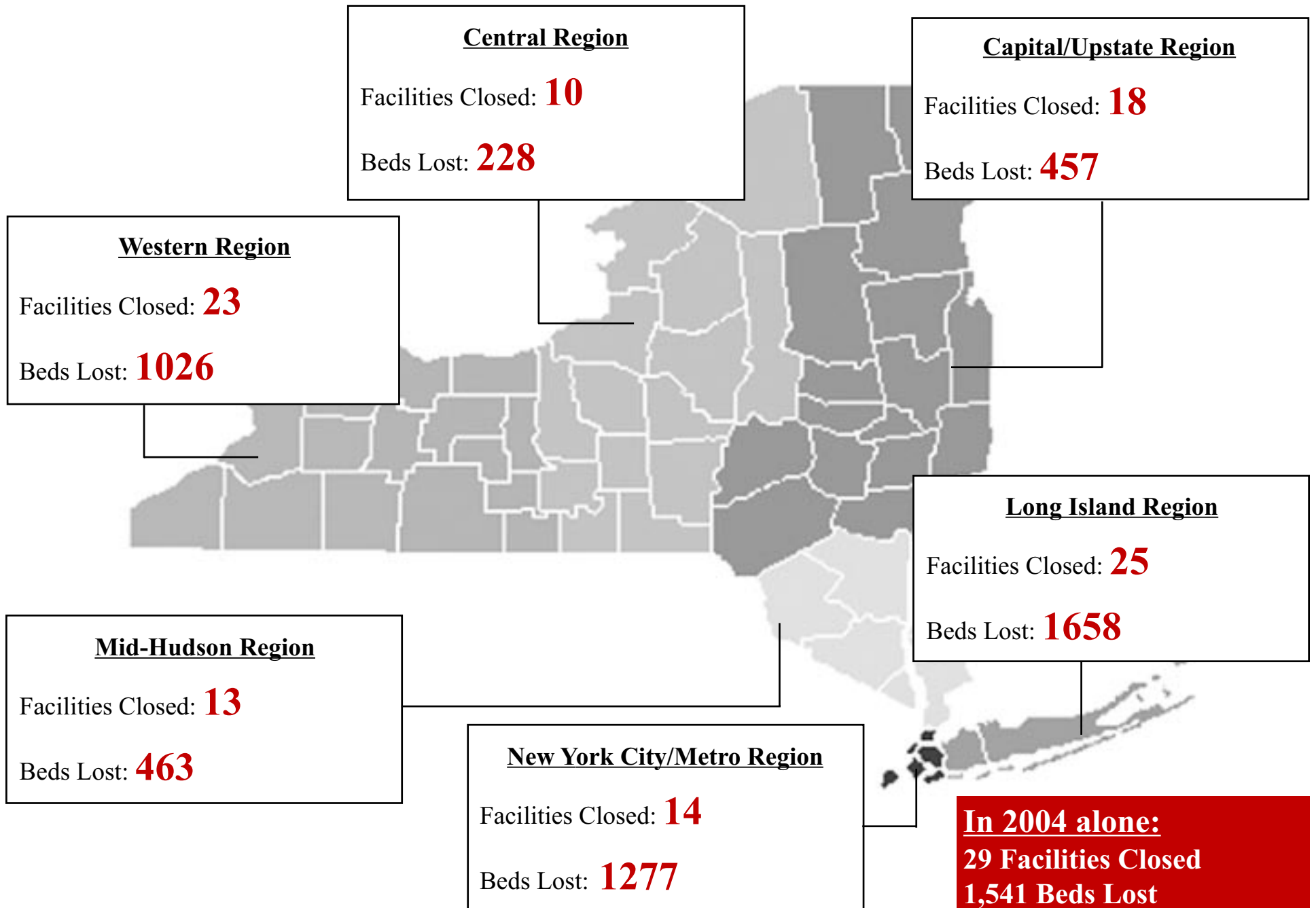


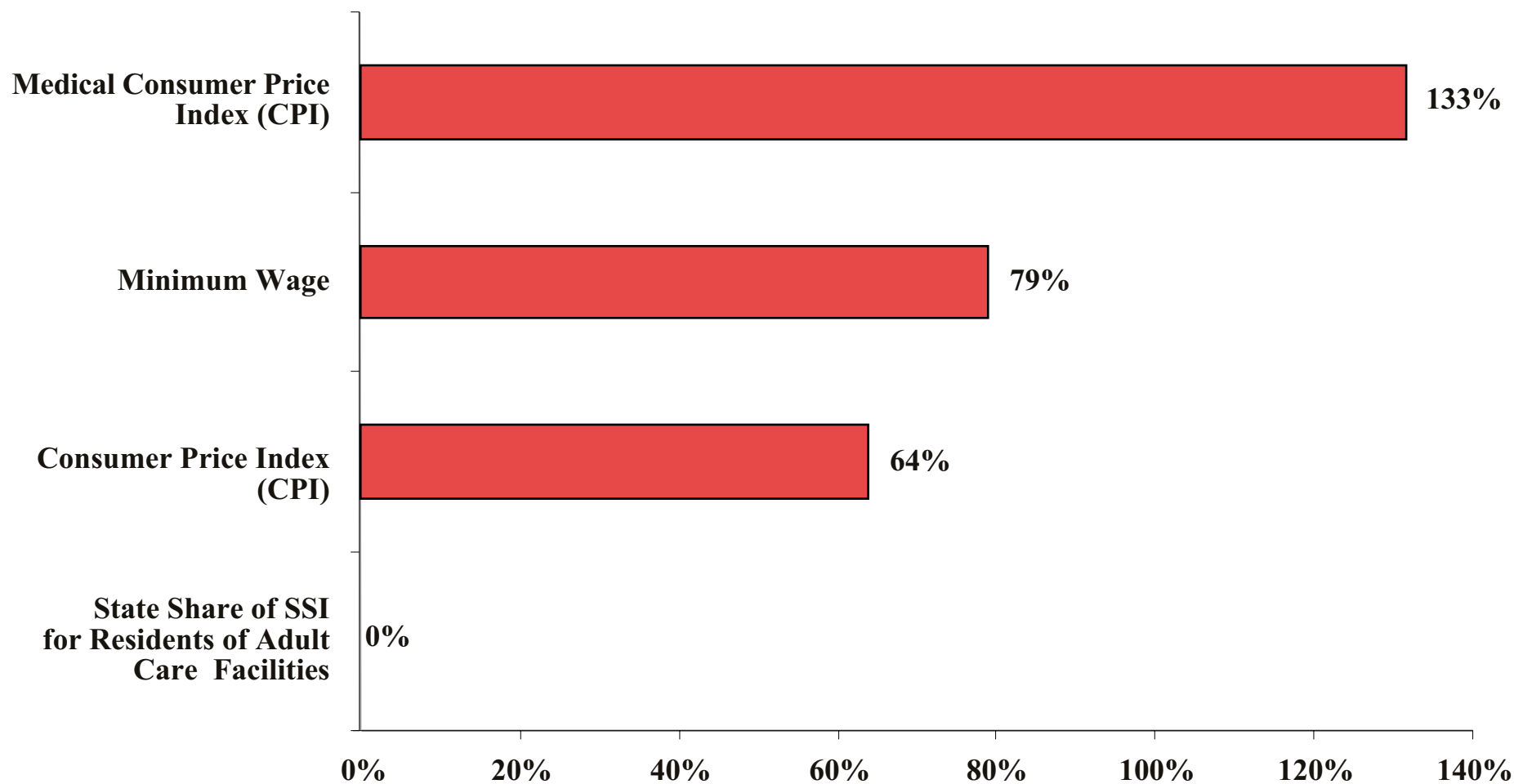
Adult Home Closures, 1999-Present

Why Now?

The Crisis is **Escalating ...**
Medicaid Costs are **Rising ...**

2004: 29 Adult Homes Closed, 1,541 Beds Lost

- Percentage of adult home residents relocated to nursing homes*: **39%**
- Additional State Medicaid cost per nursing home resident/per day*: **\$40**
- Additional State Medicaid cost per nursing home resident/per year*: **\$14,600**
- Annual State Medicaid costs resulting from 2004 adult home closures: **\$8.8 million**
- Cumulative annual State Medicaid costs resulting from adult home closures since 1999: **\$29 million**
